Since opening its doors in 2009, Uplift has seen a great deal of interest from the local community in the arts. To date we have 200+ members who come to participate in classes every week and this number steadily increases as word of mouth spreads.

Founders and Directors

Ryan and Amy Moffett both received their training at California Pacific College of the Performing Arts in Corona, California. They toured in over 20 countries teaching and performing with 'The Young Americans'. To date they have created over 75 productions with Uplift, including Northern Ireland's first ever Dinner Theatre. Over the years they have also help build relationships with the 'West T Hill Community Theatre' in Kentucky and 'Centerstage Performing Art Academy' in Tennessee, USA.

Ryan and Amy have been blessed over the years to have a number of teachers and volunteer members who help to put each show together.

WEEKLY CLASSES

We cover the three main disciplines of performing arts in all our branches, Voice, Dance, and Stagecraft, and use these to help all students increase in confidence and self-esteem.

Larne Classes

Classes in Larne are run from St. Cedma's church halls (beside football grounds). The classes are held on Friday evenings at the following times:

Nursery to P3 – 6.00pm to 7.00pm
P5 to P7 – 7.00pm to 8.00pm
1st Year & UP – 8.00pm to 9.00pm

Greenisland Classes

Classes are held at Greenisland Church of Ireland on the Station Road on Wednesday afternoons at the following times:

Nursery to P4 – 4.00pm to 5.00pm
P5 & UP – 5.00pm to 6.00pm

WORKSHOPS & EXTRAS

We run a number of workshops for local schools. These can consist of school assemblies, P7 Leavers concerts, after school clubs, GSCE projects and many more. Workshops can be specifically designed around your needs.

We also offer dance classes for different organisations and our directors can help to put together fundraising activities for churches and charities.

Private Lessons

At Uplift we are able to provide a number of instrument classes. We teach beginner classes in guitar, piano and drums. These sessions can be organised for a time during the week that suits the student and teacher's schedules. Each of these lessons last a half hour. If you request to do grades, this can be organised with specific teachers.

Equipment & Performance Hire

Over the years Uplift has expanded its stage equipment supply and this can be hired out. We have a range of sound and lighting gear, a curtain system and an array of costumes.

BREAKDOWN OF COSTS

Registration Fee

There is a £40.00 registration fee that is due when each member or immediate family starts classes at Uplift. This payment is due after the first week of attending classes. The membership fee cannot be refunded once paid.

Classes

Each hour-long class at Uplift costs £6.00 per person.

Private Lessons

Each private lesson is a 30-minute slot per person. If the teacher must travel there will be a travel expense added. Price is arranged between the teacher and students' parents.

Rehearsals

During the year there are specific shows that require extra rehearsals outside of normal Uplift hours. These rehearsals will have a charge to cover venue hire expenses.
